PCA WINTER BOARD MEETING

The National Board meeting was held on Saturday, February 11 at Carson, CA. The club has two main board meetings a year. The Winter meeting, held usually in February and the Summer meeting held in June/July. These meeting are opportunities for the Executive Council (National President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Past President) and the National Committees to meet. The meetings also provide a time for training of new Zone Reps and Committee Chairs. There are several face to face discussions between members of different committees. Since our club is nationwide, most interactions are by phone or email. This opportunity to meet face to face is very beneficial and productive. I am a member of the National Nominating Committee. We are charged with the responsibility every two years of developing the slates of candidates for both the Executive Council and the Financial Audit Committee. During this Winter Meeting, we interviewed individuals for the Financial Audit Committee for the term of August 1, 2017 thru July 31, 2019. Our committee also does several phone interviews for members not attending the Winter Meeting. The actual Board Meeting is held on Saturday afternoon. You can view minutes of Board Meetings by going to the National website, clicking on the "Forms & Documents" link and under Category selecting "Board of Directors Meeting Minutes". The most current to-date is the Draft version of Summer 2016. These minutes were approved at the February 20, 2017 teleconference Board vote. The Winter 2017 minutes will be posted in Draft form soon.

As I mentioned earlier, on February 20 we had a teleconference Board vote. This is the second teleconference Board vote and will now be the way Board votes will be taken. FYI the Board consists of the National Executive Council (5 members), National Standing Committee Chairs (11) and Region Presidents (143). A quorum is 96 Region Presidents. There were 134 total participants on the teleconference. We voted on the following 6 items:

- 1. Approve minutes from the Summer 2016 Board of Directors Meeting Yes 122 No 0 Abstain 6 Passed
- 2. Approval to split Zone 6 into two Zones to reduce the geographic area covered by this single zone. Zone 6 currently covers sixteen regions, five states, three provinces, and approximately 1.4 million square miles.

As I mentioned earlier, the Lug Nuts event will be the final indoor gathering this Winter. On Saturday, April 1 the gathering will again move outside to Hamburg in the parking lot in front of Value City. As you know these Cars & Coffees are getting attendance of 200+ for indoor gatherings and 300 - 400 for outdoor gatherings. This has been remarkable growth in the four years since Ed Steverson started the gatherings. Our club has reached a similar point with this monthly event as it did 14 years ago with the Keeneland Concours. The event is too large for one club to host and direct. It has already become known as the Lex Ky Cars & Coffee. The Facebook page has over 750 members and monthly informational emails are sent to the BMW, Corvette, Antique Auto, Asian Sports and Porsche Clubs to name a few. Most of these clubs have gained membership as a result of the monthly gatherings. These gatherings have become the biggest car events in Lexington. Our club will get 10 - 20 attendees routinely and we get attendees from the KY Region also. As we transition to the outside gatherings in April, these gatherings will not be hosted or directed by the Porsche Club. I expect the area car clubs and individuals will continue to participate and enjoy Lex Ky Cars and Coffees as stand-alone events.
