

I've been pushing the Tudor United SportsCar Championship (TUSC) as the premiere place to follow and watch sports car racing in the US. Perhaps you tuned into the recent race at Belle Isle, Detroit, Michigan. Like me, you may have wondered where are all the cars, the Porsche factory team? Sadly, we missed out on a quality race due to a very light field of competitors. However, if you did happen to tune in, the race ended in spectacular fashion with a tight three-car battle for supremacy in the prototype class.

As for the missing competitors, June 1st happened to be the official test day for the upcoming 24 Hours of Le Mans, and the entire Porsche factory team was present. Porsche will be going all out to compete for a win in both the Le Mans GTE sports car class as well as the highly anticipated launch of their 919 Hybrid Le Mans Prototype car (LMP1).

As you may know, Audi has dominated the LMP1 class at Le Mans for the past decade. In fact, Audi has won 12 overall titles in LMP1 since 2000. Peugeot challenged Audi for dominance over the last decade, but sadly filed for restructuring in late 2013. As of late, Toyota Racing has been the primary challenger to Audi, but has seen only limited success.

Le Mans Test Day Starting Grid

Historically, Porsche has won the overall title at Le Mans 16 times. Their re-emergence at Le Mans may be the biggest news in racing. Not only have they returned to prototype racing (they have been absent since last running the RS Spyder), but also they should contend for the overall win. Additionally, they have assembled a driver lineup rivaled only by team AUDI including:

Porsche Car #14: Romain Dumas, Neel Jani, Marc Lieb

Porsche Car #20: Timo Bernhard, Brendon Hartley, Mark Webber

For the sports car fan Porsche will be running two of the new 911 RSRs under team name Porsche Team Manthey. The drivers will be as follows:

Porsche RSR #91: Patrick Pilet, Joerg Bergmeister, Nick Tandy

Porsche RSR #92: Marco Holzer, Frederic Makowiecki, Richard Lietz

You may be asking, where is American Porsche factory driver Patrick Long? Don't worry, he will be running at Le Mans as well. Patrick will be driving in the #77 Porsche GT3 RSR LMGTE AM class with team Dempsey Racing – Proton. His co-drivers will be Joe Foster and actor Patrick Dempsey.

Overall, Porsche is bringing a huge contingent of cars and drivers to Le Mans. Each of their teams are capable of class wins, but all eyes will be on their LMP1 effort to see if they have any ability to challenge the dominant AUDI team (running 3 prototype cars).

The 2014 24 Hours of Le Mans will be run Saturday June 14. Most certainly, the event will be televised and many 24-hour web broadcasts will be available. (This may be the biggest event for Porsche Motorsports in the last decade.) Will the mark be able to recapture the glory days of old; will its sister company Audi continue its domination of LMP1 at Le Mans; how will Porsche show in the GT classes?

Win or lose, Le Mans is perhaps the greatest auto race on earth. I for one will be sure to watch every minute.
