

Questions from PCA.ora

Synthetic oil

Q: What are your thoughts about switching to a synthetic oil on an older car? A: If you have a moment do a search on this subject. It is commonly discussed. My thoughts are that even though swelling agents in oil have gotten better the synthetics still have a smaller molecule size. These will slip past old seal. The swelling agents help to keep the seals out and prevent leaks, however they still may occur. If the car has been run on regular oil and is not a new rebuild or rebuilt at all then I would continue to use the regular oil. The synthetic oil is without a doubt better, but what is more important is changing oil on a regular schedule. The oil will always do its job if it is in good shape. I am a firm believer that 3K miles is still a good choice and cheap insurance for an oil

Cloudy paint

Q: The paint has developed a cloudy effect. The paint is smooth, no scratches. I'm not sure if it is the product I'm using or my application of them. I use 3M hand glaze and P21 wax. Priorly I was using Griot's products and wonder if that's the reason for this cloudy effect. What shall I do to bring the paint back to crystal clear. I have noticed that in humid days the effect gets worse. I have polished the car, it becomes clear, but after a couple of weeks the cloudy effect comes back; showing like the polishing or waxing circular strokes. I show the car but lately the cloudy effect is becoming too obvious.

A: I would use the P12S paint cleanser I have found it to give great results along with the P21Wax The Hand glaze fills scratches and does not remove them. This could be why your results are not as good.

Warm up time

Q: I have heard various opinions on the proper start up/warm up procedure for a 3.21. I also wonder what is the minimum recommended amount of miles to put on the car for each time it is driven. I live about 4-5 miles from the office. but don't like to drive it there very much due to the short distance. Any thoughts?

A: My recommendation has always been to start the car, and drive away, staying below 4500 until it warms up some. The engine will warm up faster when driven than sitting in your driveway. I think when driven, the engine needs to reach full operating temperature and stay there a bit, just to get the moisture out of the oil. I agree with you that 4-5 miles is not enough. You should change your oil more often if you use it much under those conditions. The accumulation of moisture due to condensation is your worst enemy.


