Here are the nearby track events for early 2007. Registration is already open for the first several; gotta plan ahead in this hobby!

3/9-10: Alabama Region at Barber Motorsports Park. This is Friday/Saturday and is for solo drivers only. It's a PCA club race weekend and all DE drivers will be in the same run group. Registration is open and I've signed up.

3/16-18: Zone 2 at VIR, full course. Online registration opens 1/15. I'd do this one if it wasn't on the weekend in between my other two events.

3/24 Lee Grimes at Putnam Park. Registration open but this is a small event so Lee pretty much fills it with past customers.

4/14-15: Ohio Valley at Mid-Ohio. Registration opens Feb 1.

4/20-22: Central Indiana Spring Brake at Putnam Park. Good people, nice event. Nothing on their website yet but this is the date on Putnam Park's online schedule.

I'm using my off season to spend big bucks on my suspension; I'm not even upgrading it, just replacing well-worn (OK, maybe just slightly abused) parts from 1992. Steering rack, balljoints, tie-rods, caster blocks, motor mounts. Should have it back on the road in plenty of time for my first event.

You've probably seen--if you care about sports car racing--that the Dyson team is running Porsche RS Spyders in the American Le Mans Series this year, moving to the P2 class and leaving the diesel Audis effectively alone in P1. There will be nine or ten cars regularly in P2 for 2007: two Penske Porsches, two Dyson Porsches, three Acuras, a Lola, a Radical, and a Mazda/Courage--a far cry from 2004 when there were usually three and a car simply had to finish to get on the podium. Should be an interesting season; the first race is the Twelve Hours of Sebring on March 17.

This is my last Track Action article. For the rest of 2007 Benson Miller has agreed to keep the club informed about imminent nearby DEs and give you his perspective on track driving and car preparation. I'll still be around; see you in the paddock.


